A Tour of the Niagara Escarpment

The Niagara Escarpment is a designated wine grape growing region running through Northeast Wisconsin. Few people know that the area is the "Napa Valley" of the Midwest. Three local vineyards are teaming up to provide an educational, viticultural experience that most people think you have to go to California or Italy to experience. The day begins at Trout Springs Winery for breakfast and an education about the Niagara Escarpment and how the geology of it has created a boon to the grape growing industry. Samples of their wines are included. Then, it's off the Ledgestone Vineyards for more tasting and insight about the art of winemaking. A box lunch is included on the way to our next stop, Parallel 44 Vineyard and Winery. Walk through their rolling Tuscan-like vineyards while learning about the winemaking process. The day concludes at the Algoma Farmers Market Kitchen where you will have a cooking and entertaining class, followed by a gourmet winemakers dinner, featuring the wines of Parallel 44, in their beautiful rustic setting on the shores of Lake Michigan. Guests will leave with a wonderful gift and memories of a leisurely day in the beautiful vineyards of Northeastern Wisconsin.
